High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Working on behalf of HS2 Ltd, Balfour Beatty is carrying out surveys along the Phase 2a route.

What we are doing

HS2 Ltd is proposing to make changes to the M6 Hanchurch Interchange at Junction 15, Newcastle Road, Clayton Road and the junction of Newcastle, Trentham and Whitmore Road, to improve the traffic flows during the construction of HS2.

During the detailed design stage of the process, we have highlighted four areas where further utility surveys are required.

Due to the location of these surveys and to enable us to complete them safely we will need to install traffic management during the work. We have worked hard to reduce the impact however, there will be three-night shifts required to complete the work.

Resident access will also remain uninterrupted throughout.

works.

We will be onsite one hour
either side of the advised
times to set-up and close-
down the worksite.

2 Night shifts

Thursday 16 March until Friday 17 March 2023

8pm until 5.30am

M6 J15 southbound exit slip reduced to one lane, outer lane of Hanchurch Roundabout closed, A500 northbound lane 1 closed and A500 southbound lane 1 closed.

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How this may affect you

In all cases our works will be performed with hand tools with the exception of the works between Thursday 16 March until Friday 17 March 2023 on the A500 northbound. Due to the extent of these works, the excavation will utilise a vacuum excavator. We will aim to utilise this at the start of the shift to reduce the impact of the works. Some noise should be expected during these shifts.

Please plan and allow extra time for your journeys during these times.

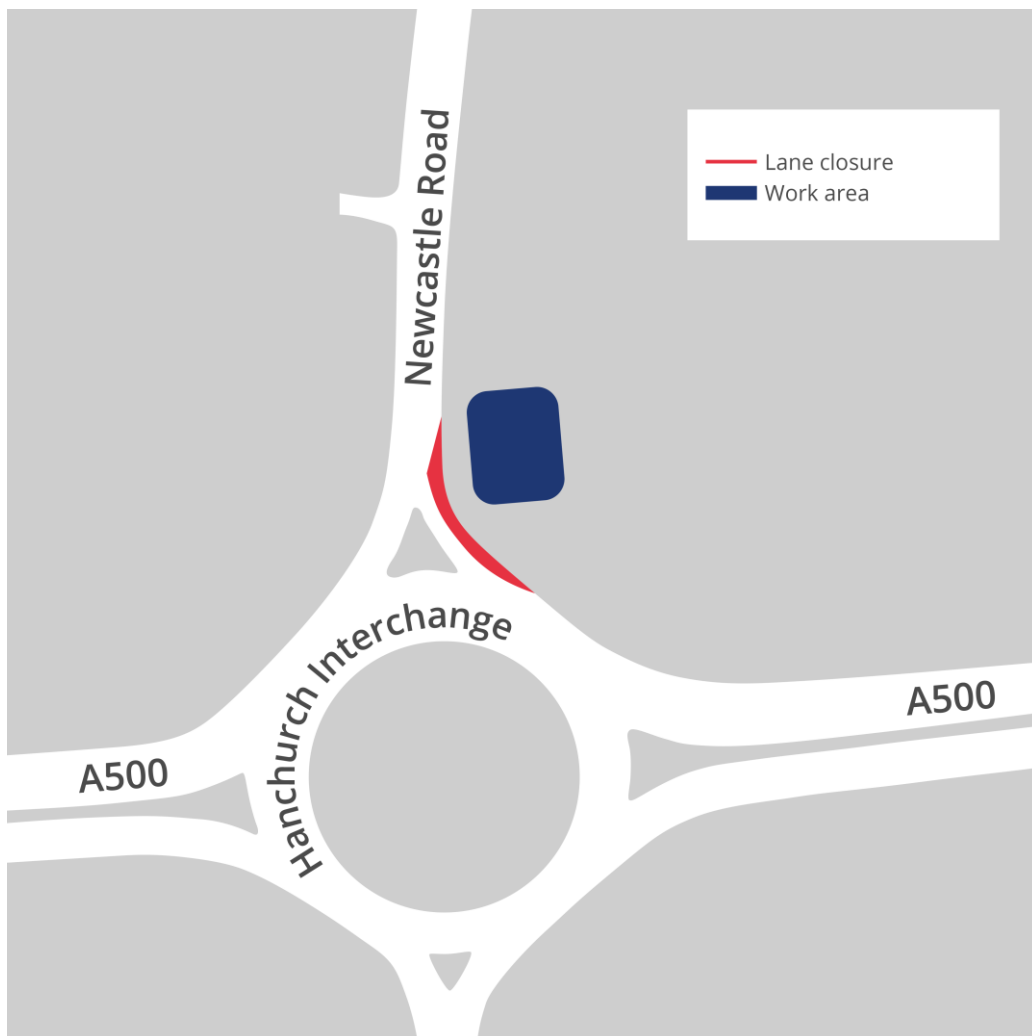

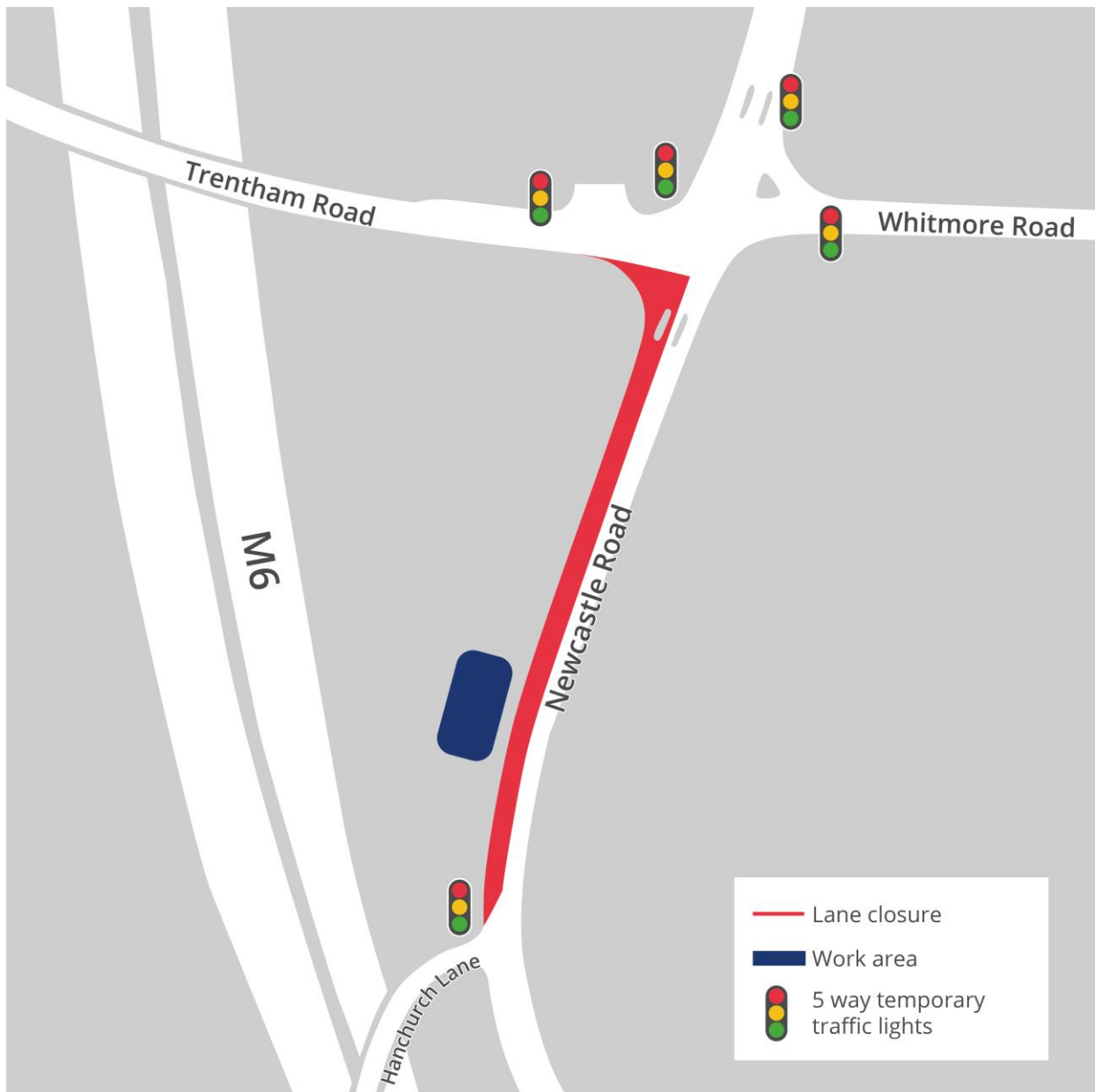
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Location 3 Five-way lights at Newcastle Road/ Whitmore Road junction, Wednesday 15 March 2023, 8pm until 5.30am



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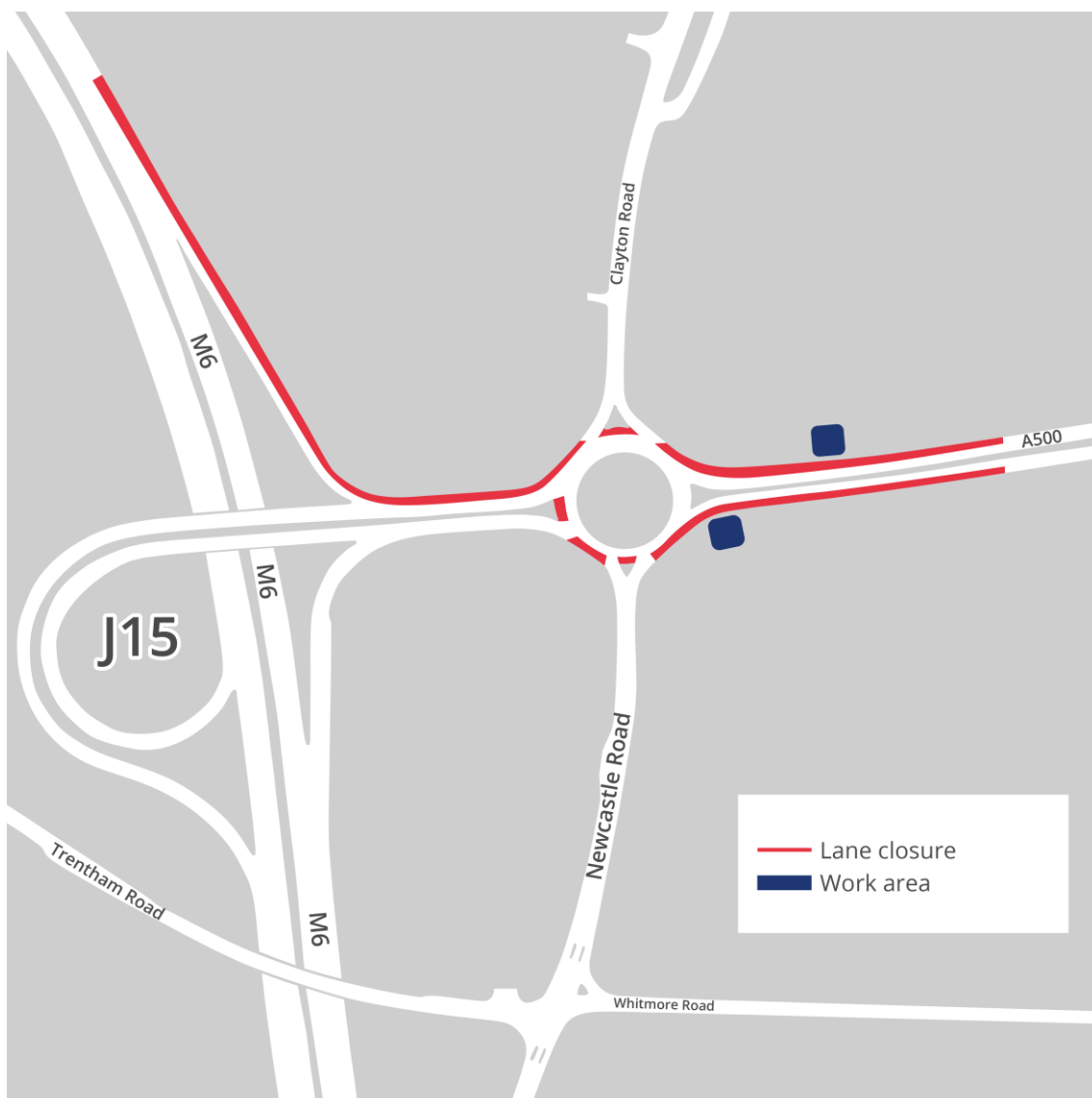
